

# BAJA COVID-19 PLAN

1. **All players, coaches and spectators will practice social distancing at all times while at Canoa Preserve Park.**
2. The dugouts will not be used by any player to access the field or to store equipment.
3. Field access will be by the equipment gate which will be sanitized before each game/practice.
4. Player equipment and bags will be hung on the fence outside the field a minimum of 6 feet apart.
5. No spitting or sunflower seeds will be tolerated.
6. In the spirit of good sportsmanship, at the completion of every game, teams will line up facing each other 6 feet apart to thank each other.
7. Teams playing the following game will not affix their equipment to the fence until the current players have exited the field and removed their equipment.
8. On deck batters will retrieve the batter runner's bat by the barrel and place it on the bat rack.
9. It is the responsibility of the runner to make his or her best effort to avoid contact with a defensive player.
- 10A. Facemasks must be worn by everyone within the Chuck Catino Softball Complex with the following exceptions:
  1. Batters who are at bat
  2. Runners on base
  3. Players on defense (except the catcher)
11. There will be hand sanitizer available at all times for both teams while games are being played.
12. No player may use another players equipment.
13. Participants who have been exposed or who have tested positive for Covid-19 must immediately notify their manager, member of the board of directors, or a grounds crew member who must immediately notify the BAJA Board of Directors. The BAJA Board of Directors will then make a determination as to the eligibility of the participant to return per the CDC recommended practices. All members of the participant's team will be notified along with the opposing players.
14. All participants will be required to sign a Release of Liability and Waiver. No one will be allowed to participate in a BAJA activity without signing a Release of Liability and Waiver.
